SECOND SUNDAY AFTER CHRISTMAS

- First Reading (Ecclesiasticus 24: 1-2, 8-12): This is a poem in praise of wisdom, a wisdom that has pitched her tent among God's chosen people.
- Second Reading (Ephesians 1: 3-6, 15-18): This reading introduces the theme of God's loving plan of salvation for us.
- **Gospel (John 1: 1-18):** As the Son of God, Jesus existed from the very beginning of time, sharing the divine life of the Father. But then He became man, sharing our human lives in order to give us a share in His divine life.

We continue to greet the Word made flesh that now dwells among us, and we continue to rejoice because, as the wisdom of God, He dispels our darkness and illuminates our lives.

EPIPHANY OF THE LORD (LITTLE CHRISTMAS)

The Greek word Epiphany (epiphanos), which means appearance or manifestation or showing forth, is used to describe Jesus' first appearance to the Gentiles. Originally the word Epiphany referred to the visit of a king to the people of his provinces. "Epiphany" refers to God's Self-revelation as well as to the revelation of Jesus as His Son to all mankind. The angels revealed Jesus to the shepherds, and the star revealed Him to the Magi, who had already received hints of Him from the Jewish Scriptures. Later, God the Father revealed Jesus' identity to Israel at His Baptism in the Jordan. In the synagogue at Nazareth, Jesus revealed Himself as the promised Messiah. Finally, Jesus revealed Himself as a miracle worker at the wedding of Cana, thus revealing His Divinity. These multiple revelations are all suggested by the Feast of the Epiphany.

What happens at the Mass?

We Gather - We gather together as God's family just as Jesus taught us - "For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them." (Matthew 18:20)

We Listen - We listen to readings from the scriptures proclaimed by ministers of the word. The priest then reads the Gospel and gives a homily, explaining God's word to us.

We Celebrate - The gifts of bread and wine are brought to the altar and we celebrate the liturgy of the Eucharist. We receive the Eucharist after praying the words of the Centurion from the Gospel: "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed."

We Go Forth - At the end of Mass the priest offers us a blessing and we go in peace.
