SHARING THE WORD OF GOD TODAY

The readings for the 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C teach us about mercy, forgiveness, and love. First Reading (1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23): David shows mercy to Saul, sparing his life even when he has the chance to kill him. This teaches us to choose mercy over revenge.

Second Reading (1 Corinthians 15:45-49): Paul explains that we are to bear the image of Christ, the heavenly man. We are called to live like Christ.

Gospel (Luke 6:27-38): Instead of seeking revenge on one's enemy this Gospel urges us to show forgiveness and compassion towards all.

These themes show us how to live like Jesus in our everyday lives. By following these teachings, we can grow closer to Jesus and share His love with those around us.
