# **'THE LORD IS COMPASSION AND LOVE'**

(Psalm 102: 8)

#### **SHARING THE WORD OF GOD TODAY**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent Year C helps us reflect on God's call, repentance, and growth. The readings from Exodus, Corinthians, and Luke guide us to understand our faith journey better.

First Reading – Exodus 3:1-8A, 13-15: Moses encounters God in a burning bush at Horeb. Instructed to remove his sandals on holy ground, he is tasked to rescue Israelites from Egypt, armed with God's name, "I AM."

**Second Reading** – 1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12: Though all the people of Israel were led out of Egypt and enjoyed God's protection in the desert, yet because of their infidelity most of them perished there. Their failures in the wilderness warn us against evil cravings and complacency.

**Gospel** – Luke 13:1-9: Jesus says that the misfortunes which befall people are no indication that they are sinners. Yet, to His Jewish hearers, He stresses the necessity of repentance and tells them that time is running out.

The readings guide us to live more faithfully and trust in God's promises.
