



(Mark 12: 34)

#### **LOVE OF GOD AND NEIGHBOUR**

On the 31<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B, we reflect on key teachings from Deuteronomy, Hebrews, and the Gospel of Mark. These readings guide us in understanding *love*, *obedience*, *and Jesus' eternal priesthood*.

- **First Reading** Deuteronomy 6:2-6: Moses instructed the people to fear and obey the Lord, promising growth and prosperity. 'Love the Lord with all your heart, soul, and strength, and take these words to heart.' This shows the importance of putting God first in our lives.
- **Second Reading** Hebrews 7:23-28: Jesus is our eternal high priest who intercedes for us. He is holy and offered Himself once for all. His priesthood is perfect and unchanging, unlike the priests of the old covenant.
- **Gospel** Mark 12:28 b-34: A scribe asked Jesus about the greatest commandment. Jesus answered, saying to love God completely and love your neighbour as yourself. The scribe agreed, and Jesus affirmed his understanding.

True discipleship involves listening to God and loving Him above all else, integrating this love into every part of our lives. And true love for God naturally leads to loving others and keeping God's commandments. Let us strive to live out this love in our lives, building up the Kingdom of God through our faithful actions.

#### NEW ENCYCLICAL FROM POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis has released his fourth encyclical, Dilexit Nos (He Loved Us), focused on the human and divine love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ. "The symbol of the heart has often been used to express the love of Jesus Christ. Some have questioned whether this symbol is still meaningful today. Yet living as we do in an age of superficiality, rushing frenetically from one thing to another without really knowing why, and ending up as insatiable consumers and slaves to the mechanisms of a market unconcerned about the deeper meaning of our lives, all of us need to rediscover the importance of the heart."
